# **Authority Projects**

# **Operations – Executive Director**

<u>Operations Report – Water/Sewer</u> – Mr. Ervin referred the Board to the written operations reports.

<u>FCWTP Valve Replacement</u> – Ms. Halderson and Mr. Ervin provided an update to the Board. More detailed information will be provided at the October meeting.

<u>FCWTP Operations Building</u> – The Operations building upgrade construction will begin November 6, 2023.

<u>Truck Inventory</u> – Mr. Ervin reviewed the truck inventory with the Board. On motion of Mr. McGowan seconded by Mr. Thompson, the Board authorized staff to sell the Jet Truck and the 2009 Ford F-250 on Municibid, by a vote of 4-0.

<u>Internal Controls</u> – Ms. Halderson reviewed the changes that have been made to the internal controls of the Authority to ensure separation of duties. The Board directed staff to have the Township Finance Department review the Bank Reconciliation on a monthly basis for added controls within the Finance Department.

<u>Professional Service Agreement – 1901 Guinea Lane</u> – On motion of Mr. McGowan seconded by Mr. Thompson, the Board approved the Professional Service Agreement between the Authority and 1901 Guinea Lane, by a vote of 4-0.

The Board entered an executive session at 7:25 to discuss Right To Know matters. The Board reconvened at 7:45 pm. No action was taken.
