REVIEW CHEMICAL BID

<u>Soda Ash Dense Bid</u> – Mrs. Halderson presented the bid results to the Authority Board members. After a tabulation of the bid results were reviewed, the following actions were taken by the Board. Upon a motion of Mr. Rockovich, seconded by Mr. McGowan, the Board awarded Northeast Chemical, a 1-year contract to supply Soda Ash Dense for a price of \$18.44/50# bag, by a vote of 5-0.
